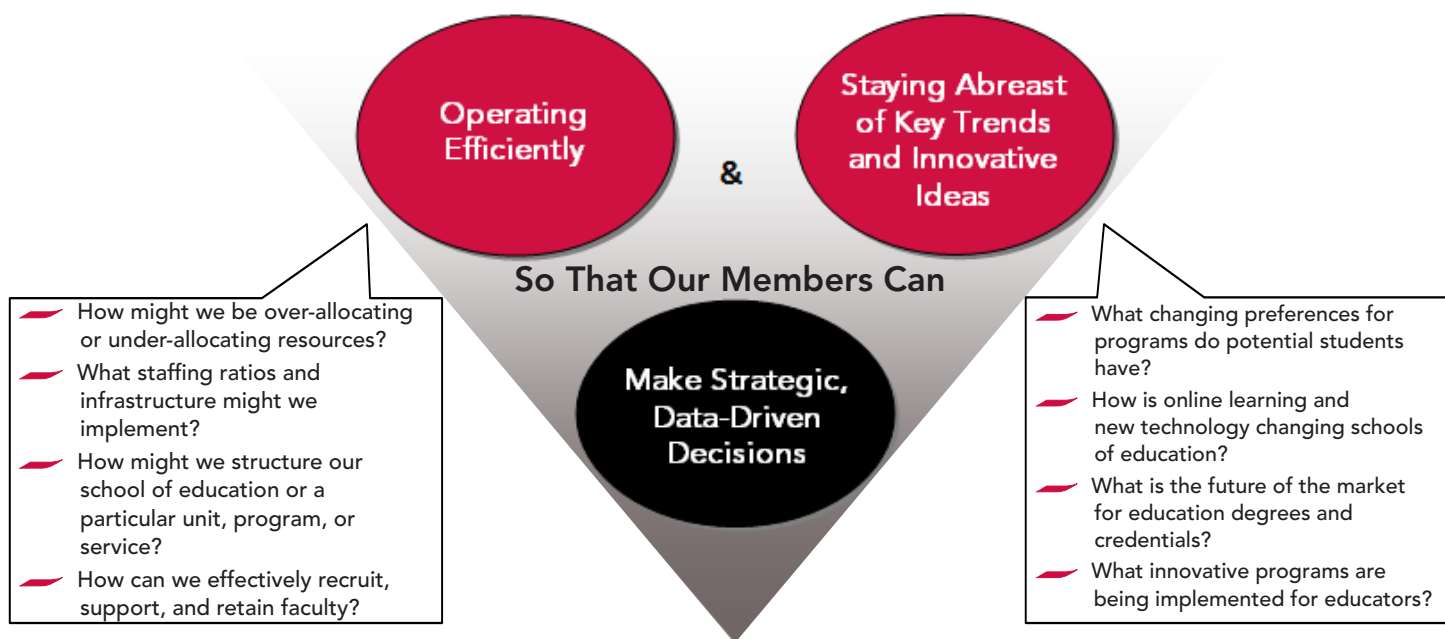


The Schools of Education Learning Collaborative Provides Data, Advising, and Networking to Support Our Members in:
